Boilers FC is a competitive soccer club located in the Greater Lafayette Indiana area. The club has 30 teams with over 350 kids participating with the club. The Club is run by a volunteer Board with a paid administrator. The Club's philosophy is to provide an opportunity for players to develop within the best possible soccer playing experience and develop a love for the game. We aim to accomplish this by developing the players while using soccer not just for its technical skills, but also for the players' social and the physical development. Currently all teams participate in the Indiana Soccer League.

Description:

Reporting to the Boilers FC Board, the Director of Coaching (DOC) will recruit, direct and supervise the coaching staff, interact with players and parents, and is ultimately responsible for meeting the Club's overall objective relative to coach, player and team development. This person will interact with both the State administration and other DOCs in the state.

Qualifications:

- National "C" License and above or the ability to obtain within a certain time frame. DOC license preferred, or willingness to obtain
- DOC experience preferred or a minimum 5 years coaching experience
- Excellent communication and motivation skills with players, parents and coaches, including conflict resolution skills.
- Possess integrity and follow sound ethical standards
- Commitment to club and the ability to work collaboratively with board members
- Ability to assess current operations, brainstorm ideas and integrate new ideas into the club

Job Description:

- Identify and recruit new coaches. Work with new coaches to integrate them into the Club. Assist with coach development.
- Observe and evaluate practice sessions. Offer guidance where necessary.
- Conduct coach evaluations prior to team assignments and make recommendations for coaching assignments.
- Plan and conduct club tryouts and evaluation/team placement of new and current players.

- Oversee and supervise all of Boilers FC player development initiatives by working with coaches and club trainers. Supervise club training sessions. Implement and manage training curriculum.
- Act as the Boilers FC liaison on issues that may affect the Club, including representing the Club at any functions, meetings, events as directed. This will include State and DOC meetings.
- Attend training sessions/games.
- Plan and conduct both coach and parent meetings prior to the start of the season.
- Assist Directors with dispute resolutions with parents and coaches.
- Coordinate and administer winter training sessions.
- Coach a team if determined necessary by the Board.
- Represent the organization in all times in a professional manner.
- DOC will not engage in any soccer related positions unless approved by the Board.
